
PRIVACY POLICY

BACKGROUND:

This Policy applies as between you, the User of this Website and Cooper Freer Ltd the owner and provider of this Website. This Policy applies to our use of any and all Data collected by us in relation to your use of the Website.

1. Definitions and Interpretation

In this Policy the following terms shall have the following meanings:

“Data”	means collectively all information that you submit to the business via the Website. This definition shall, where applicable, incorporate the definitions provided in the Data Protection Act 1998;
“Cooper Freer”	means Cooper Freer Ltd of 44 Kenilworth Drive, Oadby Industrial Estate, Leicester LE2 5LG
“User”	means any third party that accesses the Website and is not employed by Cooper Freer or Cooper Freer Limited and acting in the course of their employment; and
“Website”	means the website that you are currently using (www.cooperfreer.co.uk) and any sub-domains of this site unless expressly excluded by their own terms and conditions.

2. Scope of this Policy

3. Data Collected

- 3.1 name;

- 3.6 contact information such as email addresses and telephone numbers;
- 3.7 demographic information such as post code, preferences and interests;
- 3.8 IP address (automatically collected);
- 3.9 web browser type and version (automatically collected);

- 3.10 operating system (automatically collected);
- 3.11 a list of URLs starting with a referring site, your activity on this Website, and the site you exit to (automatically collected);

We do not store credit card details nor do we share customer details with any 3rd parties

4. Our Use of Data

- 4.1 Any personal Data you submit will be retained by Cooper Freer.
- 4.2 Unless we are obliged or permitted by law to do so, and subject to Clause 5, your Data will not be disclosed to third parties.
- 4.3 All personal Data is stored securely in accordance with the principles of the Data Protection Act 1998. For more details on security see Clause 11 below.
- 4.4 Any or all of the above Data may be required by us from time to time in order to provide you with the best possible service and experience when using our Website. Specifically, Data may be used by us for the following reasons:
 - 4.4.1 improvement of our products / services
 - 4.4.2 transmission by email of promotional materials that may be of interest to you
 - 4.4.3 contact for market research purposes which may be done using email, telephone, fax or mail. Such information may be used to customise or update the Website.

5. Third Party Websites and Services

- 5.1 Cooper Freer may, from time to time, employ the services of other parties for dealing with matters that may include, but are not limited to, payment processing, delivery of purchased items, search engine facilities, advertising and marketing.
